

Privacy Policy

Your privacy is very important to us at AmBoss Corp. We maintain the following fundamental principles:

- We don't ask you for personal information unless we truly need it.
- We don't share your personal information with anyone except to comply with the law, develop our products, or protect our rights.
- We don't store personal information on our servers unless required for the on-going operation of one of our services.

Below is our privacy policy incorporating these goals:

AmBoss Corp. ("AmBoss") is responsible for the content of this web site. It is our policy to respect your privacy regarding any information we may collect while operating our website.

Website Visitors

Like most website operators, AmBoss collects non-personally-identifying information of the sort that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request. AmBoss's purpose in collecting non-personally identifying information is to better understand how AmBoss's visitors use its website. From time to time, AmBoss may release non-personally-identifying information in the aggregate, e.g., by publishing a report on trends in the usage of its website.

AmBoss also collects potentially personally-identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses. AmBoss does not use such information to identify its visitors, however, and does not disclose such information, other than under the same circumstances that it uses and discloses personally-identifying information, as described below.

Gathering of Personally-Identifying Information

Certain visitors to AmBoss's website choose to interact with AmBoss in ways that require AmBoss to gather personally-identifying information. The amount and type of information that AmBoss gathers depends on the nature of the interaction. For example, we ask visitors who request pricing to provide a username and email address. In each case, AmBoss collects such information only insofar as is necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of the visitor's interaction with AmBoss.

AmBoss does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below. And visitors can always refuse to supply personally-identifying information, with the caveat that it may prevent them from engaging in certain website-related activities.



Aggregated Statistics

AmBoss may collect statistics about the behavior of visitors to its websites. For instance, AmBoss may monitor the most popular pages on the ambosscorp.com site or use spam screened by the Norton Security Service Program to help identify spam. AmBoss may display this information publicly or provide it to others. However, AmBoss does not disclose personally-identifying information other than as described below.

Protection of Certain Personally-Identifying Information

AmBoss discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information in order to process it on AmBoss's behalf or to provide services available at AmBoss's websites, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others. Some of those employees, contractors and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using AmBoss's websites, you consent to the transfer of such information to them. AmBoss will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone. Other than to its employees, contractors and affiliated organizations, as described above, AmBoss discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only when required to do so by law, or when AmBoss believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of AmBoss, third parties or the public at large. If you are a registered user of an AmBoss website and have supplied your email address, AmBoss may occasionally send you an email to tell you about new features, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what's going on with AmBoss and our products. We primarily use our various product blogs to communicate this type of information, so we expect to keep this type of email to a minimum. If you send us a request (for example via a support email or via one of our feedback mechanisms), we reserve the right to publish it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users. AmBoss takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. AmBoss uses cookies to help AmBoss identify and track visitors, their usage of AmBoss website, and their website access preferences. AmBoss visitors who do not wish to have cookies placed on their computers should set their browsers to refuse cookies before using AmBoss's websites, with the drawback that certain features of AmBoss's websites may not function properly without the aid of cookies.



Ads

Ads appearing on any of our websites may be delivered to users by advertising partners, who may set cookies. These cookies allow the ad server to recognize your computer each time they send you an online advertisement to compile information about you or others who use your computer. This information allows ad networks to, among other things, deliver targeted advertisements that they believe will be of most interest to you. This Privacy Policy covers the use of cookies by AmBoss and does not cover the use of cookies by any advertisers.

Privacy Policy Changes

Although most changes are likely to be minor, AmBoss may change its Privacy Policy from time to time, and in AmBoss's sole discretion. AmBoss encourages visitors to frequently check this page for any changes to its Privacy Policy.
